## District 32 Senatorial Scholarship Now Open

The 2021 District 32 Senatorial Scholarship is available online. I wanted to make you aware of the Maryland Senatorial Scholarship Program available to constituents within Legislative District 32. It is a 4 year scholarship offered by Senator Beidle. Applicant's scholastic performance and their family's financial situation are taken into consideration. All applications are reviewed by a dedicated group of volunteers that make up the Scholarship Committee. The Committee's recommendations will be presented to Senator Beidle prior to the end of the spring semester, and recipients will be notified of their award. Senatorial Scholarships may only be awarded to students applying for admission to an institution of higher learning within the State of Maryland, unless unique major status is approved for a non-Maryland school. If you are unsure of your Legislative District, please visit <a href="http://mdelect.net">http://mdelect.net</a>, and type in your home address. If you are not District 32, call your local Senator for directions. All applications and attachments must be postmarked or before March 31, 2021and only complete applications will be considered. The Application for the Senatorial Scholarship includes;

the completed <u>Scholarship Application</u>, it must be legible and completed in its entirety.

- An **Official or unofficial transcript** from your current educational institution
- a Typed **300 to 500 word essay** on a separate piece of paper. The topic of the essay is: If you had the authority to change your community in a positive way, what specific changes would you make and way.
- You must file the FAFSA by March 1, 2021 and include a **copy of your FAFSA**.
- Include a resume or separate sheet listing:
- Any school activities (included elected positions and years held)
- Any Honors or awards received
- Any sports, religious, or service activities you participated in.

If you were previously awarded a 4-year renewable Senatorial Scholarship, your scholarship automatically renews for a total of four years. You can determine your previous award status by checking your profile on MHEC's online electronic database - the Maryland College Aide Processing System (MDCAPS)..The application, essay, FAFSA, transcript and resume must be received no later than March 31, 2021. 
