

VOMCA Meeting Minutes - February 2, 2022

Meeting opened at 7:04pm.

Guests:

Councilwoman Allison Pickard – District 2 Administrative Assistant – Kristin Etzel – District 2 Highlights:

- Great community association; inspiring to see the work we do to improve the neighborhood.
- 2. Busy time at County Council; just held county budget town hall. Budget will be officially announced May 1st by County Executive (Stuart Pittman). Budget data developed using data from recent census. No change to our district; other districts (1 and 4) grew somewhat, and proposal was to create a 6th district to handle the increased population and balance out the current districts (Target population is 83k citizens; District 1 and 4 have 90k+ in each).
- Multiple school construction projects going on in our area. Redistricting will occur once OMHS West is complete.
 - a. OMHS West (at Papa John's Farm) occupancy Fall 2024
 - RWES new school Fall 2023
 - c. Quarterfield ES Fall 2023
 - d. OMMS occupancy Fall 2024 (groundbreaking Fall 2022 at Southgate Park)
 - e. New CAT-N on OMHS property Fall 2025
 - f. OMMN occupancy Fall 2026 (in existing CAT-N property; pending funding).
- 4. Green Infrastructure Plan: Non-regulatory; county has mapped all green space within the county. Looking into properties to be preserved to maintain green space in the County.
- Wade's Grant Traffic Circle: No definitive answer on it yet; we should have an answer when the budget comes out the second week of February.
- 6. Question brought up about a liquor store going into the shopping center by 7-11. There are no zoning regulations that would prohibit the store going into the location. There is an open storefront (where Allstate Insurance used to be) that neighbors are invited to keep an eye on for notices regarding application requests, depending on what business plans to occupy that vacant space.

1. VOMCA Treasurers Report:

a. Savings: \$1,591.96b. Checking: \$1,419.15

- c. Credit Line payments proceeding on schedule
- Membership: Currently have 41 members.
- 3. OMSC Treasurers Report:

a. Savings: \$523.65b. Checking \$4,208.48

OMSC Membership:

a. Total: 23b. Inactive: 13c. Active: 10

Minutes from January Meeting were reviewed and accepted by members present.

- Update on Paper Crier Delivery: Most of the houses have received the special print version of the Crier
- Update on OMSC Membership Drive: Going well; we still need some more emphasis on getting more members signed up.
- 8. Mulch Sale: Going well; we've sold 30 bags of mulch so far.
- 9. Update Barlowe Bolt 5K Walk/Run:
- 10. Update Tree Planting at Barlowe Field: Trees have been planted throughout the Barlowe Field property by the Watershed Stewards Academy, based at Arlington Echo. The trees along the parking lot do not significantly impact the parking availability. We anticipate potentially a 10% loss of trees this year due to weather and other issues beyond our control.
- 11. Dues are in Order:

New Business:

- 1. Easter Egg Hunt: April 9, 2022, Barlowe Field, 1 pm. We are planning for at least as big an event this year as we had last year. We plan to have a raffle table again this year.
- 2. FOOM Upcoming Events:
 - a. Community Day: March 5th. Plan to do yard work, mulch and clean-up. We have a large effort to clean-up the wooded area at Barlowe Field for future use.
 - b. Flea Market: May 21st in the OMSC Parking lot \$10 for one space, \$18 for 2 spaces, \$22 for 3 spaces. We will be serving breakfast and lunch again.

Ok, the cold and wind have created a few challenges but spring (March 20) is just 24 days 12 hours 45 minutes and 20 seconds but who is counting?

Pick up trash in the park and woods (the wind has really dropped a lot of stuff around the park) we have a few of the grabbers to use but if you have your own please bring it

Spread Mulch in the Gardens, FOOM has purchased mulch from the swim club mulch sale and is having it delivered early so we can spread it out on the 5th, come join us (if you want mulch go to VOMCA.org)

Clipping plants down so they can start their spring growth, we have many plants that need a bit of a haircut to get them ready for spring, we will have some tools if you need them

Doing some raised garden repairs, we have a few pieces that need a little TLC

We may build a small platform for the park, if it works out we will have the supplies and tools, just need a little help putting it together

If you look at the park side of the Snack Shack you will see some wood crying for help, we hope to cut and install some new plywood panels to dress it back up, during the coming months we also have lots of trim boards to change out.


