Once-A-Week Trash Collection Starts June 4

Beginning the week of June 4, trash will be collected only once a week in Olde Mill on our Recycle Day, which is Monday—no more Thursday pickups.

Set all material out by 6:00 a.m. on Monday mornings. You are limited to 4 containers of trash per collection. Use trash cans with handles and tight-fitting lids. Secure trash in strong plastic bags to help avoid odors and litter caused by insects and animals. Double-bag diapers and pet waste. Double-bagging food waste is also recommended.

Note that the number of *recycling* containers you can place at the curb is unlimited!

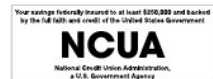

Arrests Made Quickly After Carjacking Attempt

On Saturday, May 19, 2012, at approximately 10:55 a.m., Eastern District police officers responded to the 600 block of Waterwheel Court in Millersville (Mill Pond apartment complex) for an attempted carjacking that had just occurred.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with the 56-year-old female victim, who advised that she entered her vehicle when she was approached by three juvenile males. One suspect grabbed her arm and attempted to remove her from her vehicle. The victim resisted and the suspects fled the scene toward Patriot Lane. An officer in the area located and detained the three subjects as they matched the description provided. The victim and a witness were brought to the scene and confirmed that the subjects detained were responsible for the aforementioned incident.

The three juvenile suspects, a 15-year-old male from Brooklyn Park, and two 14-year-old males from Glen Burnie were arrested, transported to Eastern District and charged on juvenile citations. One juvenile was remanded to Cheltenham and the other two were released to the custody of their parents.
