

- Bathroom cleaning

UNDER CONSTRUCTION In case you haven't seen yet . . . the playscape at Barlowe Field is now "under construction"! We held our first of many Community Build Days on Saturday, April 18th and Sunday, April 19th. With the help of our volunteers we were able to put a border around the climbing wall and fill the area in with the needed engineered wood fiber, add the hand

holds to the climbing wall and finish the taller of the two walls. The children who were up there were so excited to start climbing on it! We were able to move mulch from where the old play structure was to under the swings to help fill in the loss of wood chips over there and then we covered the area with the additional engineered wood fiber chips that we had left to help give that

area a more finished look. We were able to get the volleyball court ready for the season and take down the old play structure.

What's next for the area you ask? We are now in the process of having dirt brought in to help build up the area where we are going to build a hill slide with a tunnel and stump scramble. We will once again be doing this as a Community Build Effort and will need volunteers from our community. We will be posting on
