#### SWIM CLUB NEWS

The pool will be open on weekends and holidays: **May 23, 24, 25, 30, 31 and** June 6, 7, 13, 14. Daily operations begin June 19 (based on school closure) and closing on September 7.

Remember to return your membership form with your payment by April 30th to avoid a late fee. Membership is \$365 again this year and you will be able to pay for your membership with a credit card.



#### OVERGROW YARDS



As Spring is sprung and thoughts turn to summer; now is the time to look around you for things that impact your neighborhood.

Each year during the spring/summer season, the Dept. of Public Works receives over 1400 requests for enforcement of the Weeded Lot Law. Article 13, Title 6, of the AACO Code states that "a homeowner, occupant, or person in control of real property may not allow or maintain on their property a growth of weeds or grass that is 12 inches or higher."

If you see vacant houses with grass that is 12 inches or higher, please send a short email with the address to the board@vomca.org The County will be notified which will start the process of notifying the homeowner. Once the owner is notified, they are given seven days to make a positive response. If no response is noted, the County will start cutting on the 8th day. If notification of the owner is difficult, the process could take up to 3 weeks.

The property owner is invoiced for all charges including overhead. Failure to pay the invoice could result in a tax lien on the property. It can also cost the property owner as much as \$500 each time they fail to cut the grass and they could incur penalties up to \$1000.




