

Submissions are due by the 21st of the month in order to be included in the upcoming issue.

Anne Arundel County School Superintendent George Arlotto announced that Anne Arundel County Public Schools will hold four community forums to provide information and solicit feedback regarding a proposal to shift school start and dismissal times – pending full funding and broad community support – beginning in the 2017-2018 school year.

All forums are open to the public, but will be held in locations to make them more convenient to those in all areas of the county as indicated below. Forums will be held from 6:30 to 8 p.m. on the following dates:

- Wednesday, January 27, at Broadneck High School (Annapolis, Broadneck, and Severna Park clusters)
- Tuesday, February 2, at North County High School (Chesapeake, North County, and Northeast clusters)
- Thursday, February 4, at South River High School (Arundel, South River and Southern clusters)
- Monday, February 8, at Old Mill High School (Glen Burnie, Meade, and Old Mill clusters)

The forums are not public hearings. Those attending will be able to hear a presentation of the thought process behind the development of the plan and gain a better understanding of how the plan will work if funded and implemented. There will also be an opportunity to exchange ideas in small -group discussions.

In his Fiscal Year 2017 budget recommendation to the Board of Education, Dr. Arlotto included \$8.1 million to fund the shift beginning in August 2017. The funding would be combined with the \$602,000 allocated



by the County Council this year to enact a plan that would see high schools start at 8:30 a.m., middle schools begin no earlier than 9:30 a.m., and elementary schools open between 7:50 and 9:15 a.m. No school would dismiss later than 4:15 p.m."




