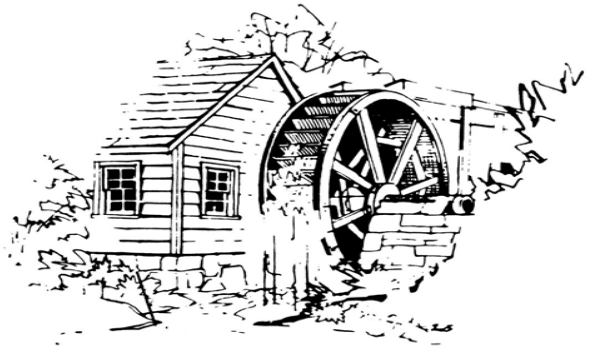

The "minimum threshold for spraying is measured in landing counts as 3 mosquitoes attempting to bite in 2 minutes or 12 female mosquitoes collected overnight in an un-baited light trap."

Please keep an eye on the playground we have found that children have written and carved names into the climbing wall. If you see this, please let us know. Please talk with your children so word can spread through the vines that we have noticed and will work on finding out who they are. We are trying to better the community and this is very sad to see knowing that it was made for all ages to use.

## MOSQUITO CONTROL

Your Community's assigned spray Night is: Tuesday

Your community will only ever be sprayed on Thursday nights during the 2016 season.

Spraying can occur anytime between 7:00 PM and 2:30 AM

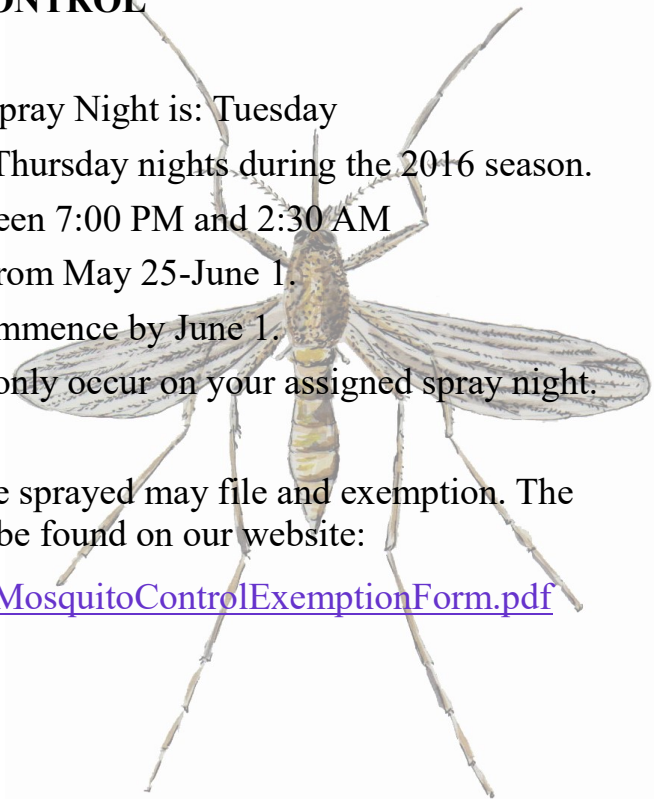
Driver training will occur from May 25-June 1.

Regular service should commence by June 1.

Any spraying during the training period would only occur on your assigned spray night.

Residents who do not wish their property to be sprayed may file an exemption. The exemption policy and form can be found on our website:
