#### The VOMCA Minutes

The Village of Olde Mill Community Association meeting on November 1, 2017 was called to order by Bev Parker, President. There were 11 members present making a quorum.

Swim Club Treasurer, Paul Shafer reported Swim Club savings: \$12,085.43 checking \$48,556.31 and that a \$4,158.00 refund check would be coming from Continental for unused guard time.

Elections were postponed till December 6 meeting.

FOOM Report: Lianne Rostad President of FOOM, reported that a bench on Barlowe Playground was broken. Was discussed if VOMCA or FOOM was responsible for this. VOMCA was never told. Bench was fixed by a FOOM volunteer, Randal Stites. Broken items are a liability of VOMCA..

Also discussed was who unlocks the Bathrooms by the fields and cleans them. Whatever organization using the fields cleans and restocks bathrooms.

Discussed why Swim Team Members must be Pool Members. They must be due to insurance liability rules.

Discussed if memberships to VOMCA have decreased since Crier is no longer hand delivered to homes. Sandy Sacra, Membership, said yes but we can not afford printing or delivery costs. The Crier is on line and delivered to members electronically.

#### **BUDGETS:**

FOOM thinks \$100 is too high for a yearly rental fee as they only use the space 3 times a year. This breaks down to \$33 per event. Softball breaks down to \$50 per event rental fee.

VOMCA Budget was voted on and passed by 10 votes, one dissenting. Swim Club Budget tabled til December meeting. (Please see proposed budget in this issue) New Pool Company is American Pools.
