Message from Randal Stites, President, Friends of Olde Mill

Thanks to Paul Shaffer, Chris Hilton, Chris Szverra, and Mary Stites for their help at the Snack Shack Saturday 6/22. The old Snack Shack serving door, on the pool side, has been replaced with a new one. It needs some detail touches and paint but I am thrilled we made that transition. Now, who wants to man it for the first day?

Our recycling program hit a snag, they did not pick up this week because the "toters "did not make it to the curb (bottom of ramp right in front of the pool gate) and there were items in the toters that were not acceptable for recycling such as plastic bags, chip bags and some other items, I need everyone's help in monitoring what goes in the recycling bins and educating our park goers of what is acceptable, we are working on some sort of signage but for now if we only put: Cardboard, Clean paper, & Empty plastic drink bottles. Everything else can go in the trash.

If we offered a **free movie night** in the field and showed old scary movies (no gore) with classic monsters like Dracula and Frankenstein, maybe even Killer Tomatoes on a Friday night, would you join us?

We still need more FOOM Volunteers, and VOMCA and Swim Club Members. Please tell your neighbors and friends about what we are doing and see if you can bring them out to meet us.

Barlowe Field Improvement Day Saturday 7/20 from 8am to 2pm

Please let me know if you will be able to join us so we can plan accordingly. We are offering hamburgers and hotdogs, soda, music and shade to all who join us, maybe even pool passes.

What do we hope to do? Glad you asked:

- Do more painting on the Snack Shack
 - o We have to finish the door green (details and additional coats in some places, the inside of the door to the pool and all of the double doors and frame of the storage room)
 - o Paint some of the walls in the kitchen and restrooms white, a little bit of peeling white paint needs to be scraped off

- o Paint the floors in the restrooms and kitchen grey, we will do the floor of the storage area later if we want to
- o The new wooden serving door needs primer and paint but PLEASE try to keep the paint off the new hardware.
- o All of the paint and supplies are on site, if you can paint between now and 7/20, I can get you access to do so.
- · We have two new light fixtures for the restrooms that need to be installed.
- Replace the women's room wax ring on the toilet and the gasket on the men's room urinal.
- Replace some of the exterior wood. Some staining of the wood may be needed.
- Ø Joe King has offered to work on retrofitting the pole lights at the pool to LED and possibly even getting us electricity (permitted and legal) to the Volleyball Poles; this is still in discussion.
- Ø The Doggy Poo Station has been delivered to my house; if it is not installed by 7/20, I could use a volunteer to put it together and mount it in the ground.
- Ø I have a source that has offered to supply us with a large volume of top soil at no charge but I have to hire a truck to move it. This soil would be used to cover the drainage stone, level the muddy area to the north of the pool, and to improve the base in the dugouts (all 4) if all goes perfectly. I have an equipment operator that has volunteered to move the dirt and level everything out for us. I will likely have to rent the equipment but it will be worth it.

The first 2 teams scheduled for the day are responsible for helping with field setup.

The last 2 teams scheduled for the day are responsible for helping close down the field and trash pickup.

\$800 League fee due by start of 1st season game (games may be forfeited if not paid).

A player on your team will only be eligible for the end of season tournament if he played in 8 games during regular season (on any team).

A qualified player can play on any team during a fournament, but must remain on that teams rooter throughout the duration of the fournament.

Barlow Rules, with following exceptions:

Banned Bats are found on the USSSA website. Offenders will be suspended rest of game plus next game, 2nd offense gone for season.

15 Run Slaughter Rule and 4 Innings, 12 after 5 Innings regular season. (10 after 5 Innings run rule in tournament).

4 over the fence Homeruns allowed per team, per game (If the ball hits the big tree in right field or other trees/bushes this rule also applies)

5 over the fence or hit the tree Homerun is INNING ENDING

Center Fleid is now "OPEN", meaning get what you can get.

At bat starts with a 1 and 1 count with NO WASTE

10 minute grace period for 1st game of the day to have at least 8 players

30 minute grace period to have at least 8 players for 2nd game of DH if forfeited first game.

Teams may pickup players to field 10 during regular season to avoid forfelt. See above for tournament qualifications.

If a team used pickup players and a regular player arrives he must enter in place of a pickup player.

2 weeks Forfelted will make team includible for Tournament

No penalty is applied for only using 8 or 9 players.

No time limit for end of year tournament games.

Courtesy Runners are allowed by using the last player who was OUT.

Multiple Courtesy Runners are allowed, but each player may only run once per inning.
