

Village of Olde Mill Community Association Meeting

Date: January 8, 2020

Location: Old Mill High School, Room A272

The meeting was called to order by Chris Szverra at 7:06. 9 total members were present, with two on phone standby to be present for vote, and three visitors presenting a proposal to the assembled group.

- 1. Old Business:
 - a. Treasurers Report:
 - i. Savings: \$1,590.31
 - ii. Checking: \$1,002.15
 - b. Swim Club Treasurers Report:
 - i. Savings: \$5241.40
 - ii. Checking: \$15,085.83
 - c. Membership Report: Currently have 64 households in the Association. To date, 43 have paid their dues for 2020.
 - d. Minutes from the previous meeting were reviewed and accepted unanimously by members present.
 - e. Crier, Web Page & Mailing List Overhaul: Overhaul process is still in the works.
 - f. Mllersville Soccer Association Update: Chris and Kristin Steelman were present at the meeting, along with Sean Liddy one of the soccer commissioners for Arden Recreation. Updated proposal details were presented to the voting members prior to the meeting to facilitate quicker discussion. Final decision was to create a contract for usage of Barlow Field for \$350 in the Spring and \$350 in the Fall. Additional use during the Summer for soccer clinics was included in the agreement at no additional cost. The proposal was approved unanimously by all members present. VOMCA's board will provide the correct information to be added to the insurance certificate for the field usage. The Spring soccer league is anticipated to start in mid-March and conclude in early June.
 - g. New Logo: The new logo was voted on and approved unanimously by all members present. The new logo features the Mill with VOMCA lettering below it and a circle around it. The logo and shirts will be in either a Navy or Royal Blue color scheme to keep with existing VOMCA coloring. (New logo appears on front page of Crier starting with February.)
 - h. Shades/Awnings for the Pool (Update): VOMCA and FOOM now own 5 collapsible awnings and three folding tables for community event usage. They will be stored in the back room of the snack shack.
 - i. Mulch Sale Fundraiser: Orders will be taken for the annual mulch sale fundraiser up until the Saturday, April 4. VOMCA is requesting volunteer help, particularly anyone with trucks/trailers, to assist in picking up the mulch from Annapolis and helping to deliver it. If you can help, call 202-441-1232, Randal Stites.
- 2. New Business:
 - a. Fundraisers: The next proposed fundraiser for VOMCA will be held at Brian Boru in Severna Park.
 - b. Future Fundraisers: Several proposed ideas for VOMCA fundraisers were put out. The Board is also looking for any additional ideas the community might have for future fundraisers:
 - i. Wine & Paint Party
 - ii. Tupperware sale
 - iii. Clothing Donation Drive through Value Village.
- 3. Next Meeting: The next meeting is scheduled for February 5, 2020, 7:00 P.M., in room A272 of Old Mill High School.
- 4. The meeting was adjourned at 8:48 P.M.

Message From FOOM:

This is about as quiet as it gets for our FOOM group but that does not mean we are at rest. In January we have been getting our event storage reorganized and planning this year's events, we are very excited. One of our events has actually been in process for a few months now, our annual Barlowe Bolt 5k run and 1 mile walk scheduled for 7am on Saturday March 28th. Early registration is only \$35 and you are guaranteed a race shirt, after that the registration fee is \$45 and shirts cannot be guaranteed. The onsite registration opens at 6am race day.

Bolt veterans know to just go to the Active.com website and register early, we also have an early packet pickup event so that on race day you can get out of your car and toe the start line. The event only lasts about an hour and we cheer every participant on until everyone is done. This event is for everyone, experienced runners, high school kids and groups, young kids, kids in strollers, even your dog is invited. You can choose to perform the 1 mile walk on the traditional path to the end of Chalet and back, or new this year, weather permitting, you can make two laps of the Barlowe Field perimeter path.

This is the largest FOOM fundraiser and all money collected goes directly back into improvements and repairs at the playground and park area, we rely on donations and volunteer efforts, come join us for a project.
