Speaking of the pool, there is some confusion about membership. If you are a current member, you had to have purchased a bond. Every year you have a choice. You can either pay your active dues or you can pay inactive dues. But in order to keep that bond, you have to do one or the other by the deadline. This has not changed. If you loose your bond (certificate) and you want to come back later, you will have to purchase a new bond. The inactive fee is \$85.00, the active fee is \$450.00. The bonds cost \$400.00. If we don't open, you still have to pay your inactive fee. We have a commitment to the pool. It has to be filled, have chlorine put in it and be maintained all summer regardless. It has to be inspected, which costs money and there are still some minor repairs that have to be addressed.

The pool company will work with us to see that we only pay for what we need and what they do. However, if we open we will need guards and other things in order to be ready to have you swim. If we open late, and you've paid for the year, there will be a pro-rated amount and you will get a refund. If we open and you have paid inactive dues, you can pay the difference and become active. If you have ANY questions, please contact me. Also, if the swim team does not have a season, you still need to pay inactive dues to keep your bond. We are not sitting idly by and just waiting for things to start up again. We are still having meetings on line. We are still making plans. We are still paying VOMCA's bills so we have a field when this is all over. 


TUPPERWARE FUNDRAISER
