- 1. VOMCA Treasurer's Report:

- VOMCA Meeting Banners: No further updates on acquiring banners to advertise the monthly meetings to get greater community participation.
- Fundraising Ideas (Krispy Kreme, Wendys, etc.): We are still pursuing fundraising ideas for the various community organizations. Any suggestions are greatly appreciated.
- OMSC Membership Drive: We have a volunteer (Jessica Smith) that will be calling all of the members from 2021 who did not renew their membership in 2022 to see if we can get them to return as members (active or inactive).
  - a. We have raised the annual dues this year to \$475 due to an increase in fees/costs.
  - b. We increased the season guest pass from \$100 to \$150
  - c. We decreased the certificate fee for new members from \$400 to \$300.
- Crier Delivery for February: We are planning to do a hand delivery of the February Crier. We anticipate doing the delivery around the first weekend in February. This will be an abbreviated version of the regular Crier for that month.
- 10. Dues are in order for 2023: You must be a paying member of VOMCA in order to vote on issues discussed at the monthly meetings; you do not need to be a paying member to be present at the meetings.
- 11. Crier Articles & Advertisers:

#### New Business:

- 1. Calendar for 2023: The updated calendar has been posted in the January 2023 Crier.
- 2. Pipes at OMSC/Parking Lot: One of the main underground pipes broke outside the pool Christmas Eve. We were able to get the county to shut the water off that evening. Currently we are working on trying to determine the extent of the issue and whether it is something we can repair ourselves and save money or if it is something that we will need to get a licensed contractor to take care of. We will need to get the issue fixed by March in order to be ready for when Ace comes to prepare our pool for the upcoming season.
- 3. Barlowe Bolt: Barlowe Bolt is March 25th. The event is a 5K Run/1 Mile Walk.
- 4. Mulch Sale: Sales have officially started. We will be advertising it on Nextdoor and Facebook. The price is \$7 for a 3 cu ft bag of brown or a 2 cu ft bag of red or black mulch. All proceeds go to benefit Olde Mill Swim Club.
- Ideas/Brain Storming: We are always open to any ideas/suggestions to help raise money for the various community organizations. We are also looking for suggestions to get the word out about our various community organizations and events held throughout the year.

#### Raising money for a new playground

To all of The Village of Olde Mill, happy New Year, Happy Valentines Day

Here in FOOM and at Barlowe Field, we have all invested so much time, energy, and money, and we survived Covid, but we cannot slow down. We need your help at the park: Trash has gotten out of control around the park and in our section of the woods, or maybe it has been months since we were able to spend time gathering it up. If you all can pitch in just a little to help us gather and dispose of it, our park will be in better shape when the flowers bloom. Our biggest fundraiser of the year, the event that pays for everything at the park, is occurring on March 25th in our community.

The 5k bolt and 1-mile walk is a lot of fun and inexpensive and is how we buy the trees, plants, mulch, fencing, and even garbage bags. Please, there is something for everyone; run, walk, or help us at the tables. Yes, it is early; we set up starting at 5 am, the race begins at seven and is over, and we are cleaning up by 8. I know it is winter, but things will start to bloom before you know it. I love to garden, and if you do too or want to help, we will be gardening as soon as the weather allows. If you or your family would like to sponsor a specific garden area, we can do that. There is a large pile of rough mulch in the basketball court area. We need some help to move that to the edge of the woods as part of our park management.

Many people worked very hard to recapture the area at the edge of the woods; we created a garden that the boy scouts, invested time and money, and dedicated a bench to a loved one, unfortunately, that garden has been overrun by wild vegetation (read "weeks"), and I need some volunteers to specifically restore it to its former glory by removing the weeks, laying weed block fabric down and putting in new mulch, give me a shout if you would like to help.

The bottom line is we have lots of fun things to do, but we need some help. Typically, it is just 2 to 4 hours a month on a Saturday or Sunday (depending on you), and we can achieve so much more. Give me a shout if I can add you to our volunteer call list to give back to our park.
















#### Olde Mill Swim Club (OMSC) Needs your support!
