





From the desk of the Friends of Olde Mill,

I love gardening!

A number of years ago I paused at a Barlowe Field event, and I was hooked. Since that time we have installed 62 new trees (but who is counting?) and made many other changes and improvements to the gardens, not to mention the playground and the wooded area. I have wanted to create a foundation for gardening and landscaping activities for quite some time but I need to identify some people who would like to participate, sure to make the park a pretty place, but also people who just love to garden and want to learn more. I hope to bring someone to the park in the spring that does amazing things with fruit bearing plants, I met her because of her fig trees (my dad loved growing them and I am amazed at the interest online). I need some green thumb people to help those of us without them, we can improve the gardens at the park and have a lot of fun as well, I think it is in the category of hobby.

Additionally, we will be starting to work on park needs as soon as we can, due to limited volunteers we are moving forward much more slowly than we had hoped but still moving forward. If you read last months article you are aware that we will be starting to work on the memorial garden as soon as weather allows, and we can use your help, and if you have crowded gardens at home and like me, hate to see a growing plant thrown out but are out of space to plant it, give me a call, we have lots of space. On April 20th we will have our first official spring planting day but we will be doing a lot before that so do not wait, give me a shout and let's talk about what you can do for your community, your park, and your neighbors.

Buy some mulch and help the pool and your garden, we can drop it where you are going to use it.

Barlowe 5k Bolt and 1 Mile Walk fund raiser occurs Saturday March 23rd at 7am! This is the biggest FOOM fund raiser for the park and we want your support. Despite donations all of that gardening and park maintenance is not free and this is how we pay for it. The event information is here in the Crier and we want volunteers (we really do have a good time volunteering at the park) and participants. The 5k run is not a race, it is a fund raising running (for most people) event and it is good for you, but if that is asking a bit much some and take a walk. Walkers tend to stay fairly close to each other and often it is a chance to visit with neighbors you have not seen in a long cold winter.

We are anticipating our grant requests will be approved and we will be installing a new border around the playground mulch area, and making major improvements to the asphalt sports area (otherwise known as the old basketball court). We hope to expand the asphalt and recoat it, to install a second basketball court and even a pickleball court, we cannot do it without your support.

If like us, you love your community and appreciate that opportunities we have, if you think the gardens, playgrounds, sports facilities and pool are important to the soul of our community, come on out and have some fun with us.

Raising money for a new playground

Desde el escritorio de los Amigos de Olde Mill,

¡Me encanta la jardinería!

Hace varios años hice una pausa en un evento de Barlowe Field y quedé enganchado. Desde entonces hemos instalado 62 árboles nuevos (pero ¿quién los cuenta?) y hemos realizado muchos otros cambios y mejoras en los jardines, sin mencionar el parque infantil y la zona boscosa. He querido crear una fundación para actividades de jardinería y paisajismo desde hace bastante tiempo, pero necesito identificar algunas personas a las que les gustaría participar, seguro que harán del parque un lugar bonito, pero también personas a las que les encanta la jardinería y quieren aprender más. Espero traer al parque a alguien en la primavera que haga cosas increíbles con plantas frutales. La conocí por sus higueras (a mi papá le encantaba cultivarlas y estoy sorprendido del interés en línea). Necesito algunas personas con habilidades verdes para ayudar a aquellos de nosotros que no las tenemos, podemos mejorar los jardines del parque y divertirnos mucho también, creo que está en la categoría de pasatiempos.

Además, comenzaremos a trabajar en las necesidades del parque tan pronto como podamos; debido a la cantidad limitada de voluntarios, estamos avanzando mucho más lentamente de lo que esperábamos, pero seguimos avanzando. Si leyó el artículo del mes pasado, sabrá que comenzaremos a trabajar en el jardín conmemorativo tan pronto como el clima lo permita, y nos vendría bien su ayuda, y si tiene jardines abarrotados en casa y, como yo, odia ver un crecimiento Planta tirada pero no tenemos espacio para plantarla, llámame, tenemos mucho espacio. El 20 de abril tendremos nuestro primer día oficial de siembra de primavera, pero haremos mucho antes, así que no esperes, llámame y hablemos de lo que puedes hacer por tu comunidad, tu parque y tus vecinos.

Compra un poco de mantillo y ayuda a la piscina y a tu jardín, podemos dejarlo donde lo vayas a utilizar.

¡La recaudación de fondos Barlowe 5k Bolt y 1 Mile Walk se llevará a cabo el sábado 23 de marzo a las 7 a. m.! Esta es la mayor recaudación de fondos de FOOM para el parque y queremos su apoyo. A pesar de las donaciones, todo el mantenimiento de jardines y parques no es gratuito y así es como lo pagamos. La información del evento está aquí en el Crier y queremos voluntarios (realmente nos lo pasamos bien siendo voluntarios en el parque) y participantes. La carrera de 5 km no es una carrera, es un evento para recaudar fondos (para la mayoría de las personas) y es bueno para ti, pero si eso es pedir demasiado, sal a caminar. Los caminantes tienden a permanecer bastante cerca unos de otros y, a menudo, es una oportunidad para visitar a vecinos que no has visto en un invierno largo y frío.

Anticipamos que nuestras solicitudes de subvención serán aprobadas e instalaremos un nuevo borde alrededor del área de abono del patio de recreo y realizaremos mejoras importantes en el área deportiva de asfalto (también conocida como la antigua cancha de baloncesto). Esperamos ampliar el asfalto y recubrirlo, instalar una segunda cancha de baloncesto e incluso una cancha de pickleball, no podemos hacerlo sin su apoyo.

Si, como nosotros, amas a tu comunidad y aprecias las oportunidades que tenemos, si crees que los jardines, los parques infantiles, las instalaciones deportivas y la piscina son importantes para el alma de nuestra comunidad, ven y diviértete con nosotros.

Did you know that we have a neighborhood Community Pool? When you become a member, there is no need to pay every time you want to swim, like at the Aquatic Center, or pay higher membership fees like the other community pools in the area.

Your membership helps us hire lifeguards for the season, improve the pool area, and host member events (some family and some adult only)!

Our newly renovated (2021) Snack Shack is very popular. During the 2020 season, we revamped the pool's top edge, including new tiles and coping stones, retrofit the pool area lights to LED, and replaced all the pumps! The addition of new shade structures in 2022.
