

Wrap-up Quarter Auction: It was a very successful event as a fundraiser as well as for the vendors present. We made \$428 on food sales, \$386 on raffle items and \$1,742 from the auction; gross profit was \$2,556, which resulted in \$2,182 after expenses.

VOMCA Tree Lighting – Dec 11, 2021 from 3-7pm (rain day Dec 12): Fliers have been in the recent Criers. We are planning on decorating the tree the weekend prior.

VOMCA Santa's Ride through Olde Mill on fire truck – Dec 18, 2021 starting at 2pm: VOMCA volunteers will be following behind the truck collecting non-perishable food donations for NCEON.

Common Areas – Update: Common areas within the neighborhood, with the exception of the property in/around Barlowe Field, do not belong to VOMCA; they are the property of Anne Arundel County. As such, any disputes regarding the common areas are not our responsibilities. Any further issues with county-owned areas, to include the multiple creeks that cross our neighborhood, should be brought up to the county.

What a year it has been! Thank you to everyone who joined in the effort to make the park and playground a better place for kids and families (and dogs) to get out and enjoy themselves.

I want to invite everyone out on Saturday, March 26th to participate in the 2022 Barlowe 5k Bolt Run/Walk. It is our biggest fund raiser of the year! It is the 10th anniversary of the event, and it will raise the remaining funds we need to install the rest of the playground climbing/sliding equipment. Participation is \$35 if you register early (by March 4th), \$45 after that deadline, and all early registrants will receive an event t-shirt in their packet. If you are not a runner but would like to support the playground and join the event, consider the 1-mile walk option, a lot of people love to do it. Every year we produce an event booklet where our sponsors can show their community support; but so can you, purchase a shout out to the group, the community, or someone special to you for just \$10. It is year 2 of Covid life but we still got a lot done, the swingset is installed and being used, we have refurbished several gardens, continued our efforts to improve our wooded area and we even discovered we have a Persimmon tree.




