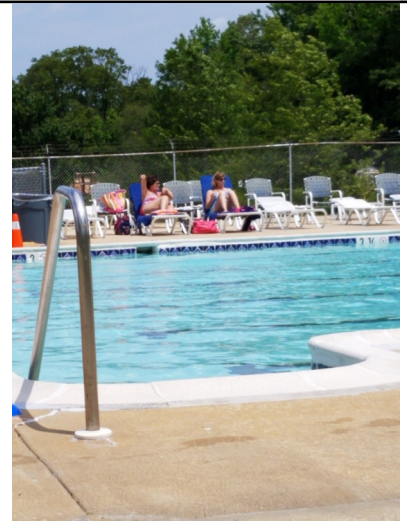

1. VOMCA Treasurers Report:

  - b. We have a new pump for the wading pool which we anticipate will be installed this weekend. Ace put new tiles up around the edge of the wading pool as well as re-installing the side wall light for the pool.

Next meeting scheduled for June 2, 7pm, via Zoom Meetings.

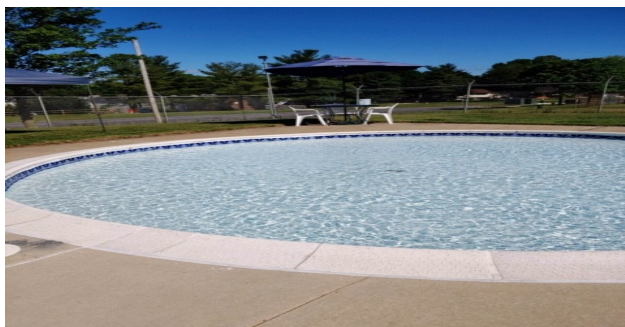

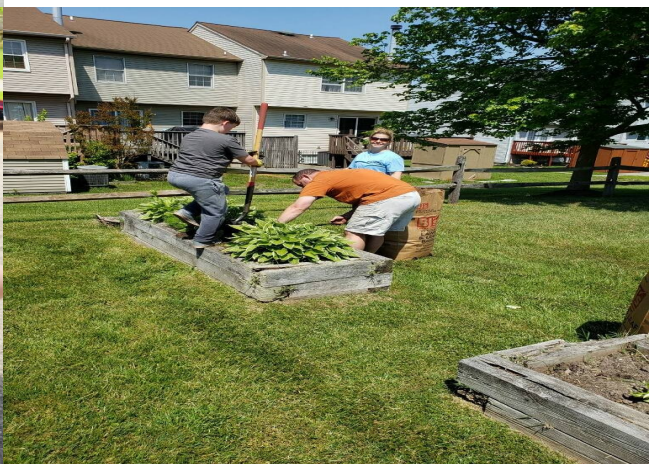

## Maryland Department of Agriculture

### MEMO

As a participant in the Maryland Department of Agriculture (MDA) Mosquito Control Program, we are writing to provide an update on the products used by the program for Ultra-Low Volume (ULV) truck-based spraying of adult mosquitoes.

Last month, the program was made aware of private lab results indicating possible Per- and poly-fluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) contaminants in Permanone 30-30. Out of an extreme abundance of caution, the program has decided to temporarily suspend use of this product while the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) conducts an inquiry into these findings. Once the EPA testing is complete, the program will make a final decision.

In the interim, the program will use BioMist 30-30 and PermaSease 30-30 for any truck-based ULV applications. These products have similar active ingredients and we have received assurances from both manufacturers that measures have been taken to eliminate the use of materials (fluorinated containers) believed to be the source of PFAS contamination in other products.

We do not anticipate any major disruption in service due to this precautionary and temporary change. If you have any additional questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact the Mosquito Control Program at 410-841-5870.

The first 2 teams scheduled for the day are responsible for holding infield setup.

SBDF League fee due by start of 1st regular game. Payment may be forfeited if not paid.

4 player on your team will only be eligible for the end of season tournament if he played in 6 games during regular season (on any team).

A qualified player can play on any team during a tournament, but must remain on that team's roster throughout the duration of the tournament.

Barlow Rules, with following exceptions:

1. 1st and 2nd base are rounded (that is, 90 degrees). Outfielders will be suspended rest of game plus next game and offense game for season.

2. 1st Base Slaughter Rule: 4 innings (2 after 5 innings regular season, (3) after 5 innings in double tournament).

3. Over the fence Home runs allowed certain per game. If the ball hits the ground in right field or other foul territory, the rule does not apply.

4. Over the fence hit the once - everyone's INNING ENDS-C

5. Center field is now "CHAIN", meaning get what you can get.

6. Action starts with Time 1 starts with "NO MATH"

7. Minimum game length for 1st game if the bylaws allow 8.5 innings.

8. 20 minute game period to have at least 9 players for 2nd game in 1st 11 night tournament game.

9. Teams may pickup players to field 10 during regular season or week before. See above for tournament qualifications.

10. 4 hour max pickup period. Teams may pickup players for the final order in close of pickup players.

11. Women's Division will have more ineligible for Tournament.

12. No penalty is applied for using only 8 players.

13. No time limit to end of year tournament games.

14. Courtesy Runners are allowed by using the best player who was OJ.

15. In play Courtesy Runners are allowed, but only if they were only in the game during.
