

Village of Olde Mill Community Association Meeting

Date: February 5, 2020

Location: Old Mill High School, Room A272

The meeting was called to order by Chris Szverra at 7:10. 8 total members were present, and two visitors presenting a proposal to the assembled group.

1. Old Business:

- a. Treasurers Report:
 - i. Savings: \$1,590.45
 - ii. Checking: \$1,552.47
- b. Swim Club Treasurers Report:
 - i. Savings: \$5236.84
 - ii. Checking: \$8,265.93
 - iii. All bills are paid to date.
- c. Membership Report: Currently, 58 households have paid their annual dues.
- d. Minutes from the previous meeting were reviewed and accepted unanimously by members present.
- e. Mulch Sale Fundraiser: Orders will be taken for the annual mulch sale fundraiser up until the Saturday prior to Easter. VOMCA is requesting volunteer help, particularly anyone with trucks/trailers, to assist in picking up the mulch from Annapolis and helping to deliver it. Sale is \$6 per bag (3 cu ft for brown/2 cu ft for red or black). Free deliveries within Olde Mill on Saturday, April 11.
- f. FOOM: Barlowe Bolt: FOOM is currently looking for sponsors for the Barlowe Bolt. Advise any that want to sponsor the event that FOOM is a registered 501c3 organization, so donations/sponsorship are tax deductible.
- 2. New Business:
 - a. Stephan and Brittany Lescallett were present at the meeting presenting a proposal. They have requested (and are raising the funds themselves) an addition/expansion to the existing playground structure at Barlowe Field. The new structure would be in memorial to a fallen member of Stephan's Army unit. The issue (as it would be affecting FOOM) was shelved to be discussed at the next FOOM meeting.
 - b. Swim Club Membership Packets: Packets are scheduled to be mailed out by the end of February. Currently there is no member representative for Old Mill Swim Team. Until further notice, the phone number referenced in OMSC applications is not valid.
 - c. Crier Updates: Moriah Haefner is pursuing an option to re-host the VOMCA (and associated organizations) websites through Squarespace. The cost for hosting would be divided evenly between the three organizations (VOMCA, FOOM, OMSC) and would total \$216 per year (\$18 per month). A vote was conducted via email following the meeting and the motion was approved.
 - d. WIFI at OMSC: The option of adding WIFI to the Old Mill Swim Club during the summer operating months was brought up. Several options were discussed, to include password protecting it or having a changing password that would be given out by the lifeguards that day. Further discussion on this was tabled for a future meeting.
- 3. Next Meeting: The next meeting is scheduled for March 4, 2020, 7:00 P.M., in room A272 of Old Mill High School.
- 4. The meeting was adjourned at 9:04 P.M.

Message From FOOM:

This is about as quiet as it gets for our FOOM group but that does not mean we are at rest. In January we have been getting our event storage reorganized and planning this year's events, we are very excited. One of our events has actually been in process for a few months now, our annual Barlowe Bolt 5k run and 1 mile walk scheduled for 7am on Saturday March 28th. Early registration is only \$35 and you are guaranteed a race shirt, after that the registration fee is \$45 and shirts cannot be guaranteed. The onsite registration opens at 6am race day.

Bolt veterans know to just go to the Active.com website and register early, we also have an early packet pickup event so that on race day you can get out of your car and toe the start line. The event only lasts about an hour and we cheer every participant on until everyone is done. This event is for everyone, experienced runners, high school kids and groups, young kids, kids in strollers, even your dog is invited. You can choose to perform the 1 mile walk on the traditional path to the end of Chalet and back, or new this year, weather permitting, you can make two laps of the Barlowe Field perimeter path.

This is the largest FOOM fundraiser and all money collected goes directly back into improvements and repairs at the playground and park area, we rely on donations and volunteer efforts, come join us for a project.


