Welcome to the March edition of the Village Crier, your local newsletter. I'd love to say spring is in the air, but as I write this, it does not feel much like spring. However, I know it won't be long before the days are milder and our playground and park will be filled with people enjoying our great neighborhood. A lot is happening right now, so let's peek at what's coming up for Olde Mill.

**Pool Packets:** All pool packets have been mailed out. Thank you for being so patient this year. Our team has been hit pretty hard with illness throughout January, and we are now getting back in the swing of things. If you haven't gotten your packet, please contact me privately at 443-852-2098, and I'll see you get one. Please consider joining early, as this helps our treasurer pay the bills due before our pool season starts.

**Annual Dues:** If you haven't paid your yearly dues, consider doing it now. It's only \$25.00, and the money goes to pay the taxes on Barlowe Field and fund our wonderful community activities throughout the year. So, support your community and pay your dues.

#### Raising money for a new playground

#### Friends of Olde Mill

Can you believe this weather? All I want is to be out doing mulch and planting flowers, making things beautiful and colorful. While unfortunately it is still a bit early for most of our garden work it will be coming very soon. We want to start in March cleaning up the park area, we really need help controlling the volume of trash that has been left in the park lately. Most of our trash cans have a few spare bags beneath the one in use if you see a full one feel free to pull it out and tie it up (please wear gloves!), leave it at the pool gate and we will take care of it, but don't forget to put a new bag in the can. I think the wind is working against us, as much of the loose trash blows into the woods and gets stuck there, we would like to clean that out before everything starts growing again and it becomes that much more difficult to do. Feel free to walk around and pick up loose trash and drop it into any one of our receptacles (except the doggy stations), we will be replacing the missing trash can at the basketball court soon. We always support the mulch sale put on as a fund raiser by the Olde Mill Swim Club, if you have not yet ordered please do soon. We use that mulch in all of our gardens and plantings. You may have noticed a large pile of coarse mulch on the basketball court, that was donated and while it is not acceptable for our gardens, we are using it to enhance the areas adjacent to the woods, yes we could use some help moving it, or a donation to get the tractor again to do it with. We are putting together a list of volunteers who would like to help out but do not know when or where, please send me your contact information and some thoughts on what you might like or be able to help out with.

A few items on our wish list that we would love support, input, and donations on are

- 1. Removing weeds, laying barrier cloth, and mulching the back memorial garden created by the Eagle Scout project.
- 2. Repairing some of the timbers on the raised gardens near the playground
- 3. Mulching all the gardens
- 4. Installing 2 metal benches near the basketball court
- 5. We would like to add some small strategically placed evergreen shrubs at the park
- 6. Cleaning out the garden under the Olde Mill sign and replanting it, and replacing the boards around it
- 7. Sealing the cracks in the parking and basketball asphalt areas with the hope of sealing the entire surface this year or next
- 8. We would like to find someone skilled and willing, ok willing is all that is really required to set up a couple of go fund me type efforts for these projects.
  - a. Replace the 2"x12" boards around the playground mulch area with timbers (about \$5,000 and work to install them)
  - b. Add additional mulch to the playground area to achieve an appropriate depth (\$900)
  - Install a new basketball court on the asphalt area. (new posts and backboards, some asphalt work and striping about \$3,000)

- d. Install a pickleball court in the asphalt area where the mulch is currently sitting (posts, net, installation and striping about \$500).
- e. Install a dog run adjacent to the basketball court (about \$3,000)
- f. Install a modest building adjacent to the pool to serve as a community use area (about \$30,000).
- g. A new Olde Mill Barlowe Field sign at the entrance to the parking lot (about \$1,500)
- h. Along Olde Mill Road downhill from the basketball court we have some shifting soil, we would like to install a garden, to include a few terraced stone walls less than 2' tall to control that movement and beautify the area near the Olde Mill Sign (about \$1,500 and install work/fun).
- i. A 2' tall stone wall along the sidewalk at Olde Mill Road from the potential garden area to the wooded area, this would both support the hill and enhance the look and public perception of our area. (about \$2,000).
- j. If the 2' wall gets built, add a 4' tall wooden fence like the one at the entrance to Wades Grant but without stone columns (about \$2,000 and install work)

Please remember all the maintenance, care, and improvements at Barlowe Field are achieved through fund raising, donations, and tons of work performed by a small group of volunteers, anything you can give financially or with your time is truly appreciated and makes our community better. That includes your thoughts and ideas. Please give your support and participation to these efforts, join us for our fundraising events such as
