New Business:

1. American Pools Update: American Pools debt has been settled as of today. Final debt was settled for \$12,000.
2. Easter Egg Hunt: We anticipated no more than 60 kids but ended up having more than 100 kids at the event Saturday. The event was very well organized and run. We also held a raffle at the event. We made \$136 total on the event after expenses for VOMCA.
3. Playground Plans: As of now, we are scheduled to have an equipment operator at the park on Saturday to help with levelling the ground around the existing swing set and the proposed area for the new playset. We plan to move components over throughout the next week (they will be staged inside the pool fence). We need volunteers to help with installing the new sets. We are anticipating starting the installation work on April 17th.
4. Flea Market: Currently planned for May 22nd. \$10 for one space, \$18 for 2 spaces, \$21 for 3 spaces. We are planning on selling hot dogs and hamburgers along with pre-packaged goods. We plan to have a FOOM table to sell Bolt shirts from previous events.
5. Snack Shack: We are planning on having the Snack Shack operational for the upcoming swim season as well as the upcoming softball season.
6. Insurance: We are still working on getting an updated policy to cover the pool

The first 2 teams scheduled for the day are responsible for helping with field setup.

The last 2 teams scheduled for the day are responsible for helping close down the field and trash pickup.

\$200 League fee due by start of first regular game. Payment may be forfeited if not paid.

4 player on your team will only be eligible for the end of season tournament if he played in 6 games during regular season (on any team).

A qualified player can play on any team during a tournament, but must remain on that team's roster throughout the duration of the tournament.

Barlow Rules, with following exceptions:

1. 1st and 2nd base are rounded (not flat). 3rd base is a circle. A circle will be suspended (not a game plus one game and offense game for season).

2. 1st Base Slaughter Rule: 4 innings (2 after 6 innings regular season, (3) after 6 innings in double tournament).

3. Over the fence Home runs allowed certain per game. If the ball hits the ground in right field or other foul territory, the rule does not apply.

4. Over the fence hit the once - everyone's INNING ENDS-C

5. Center field is now "CHAIN", meaning get what you can get.

6. Allow a walk with 1 out with NO MARGINS

7. Minimum 9 players on field for game. If the bylaws show less than 8, bylaws.

8. 20 minute game period to have at least 9 players for 2nd game in 1:11 (right field) game.

9. Teams may pickup players to field 10 during regular season or week before. See above for tournament qualifications.

10. If a team has a pickup player, you may pickup a player or over the usual criteria close of pickup player.

11. Women's Division will have more ineligible for Tournament.

12. No penalty is applied for using only 8 players.

13. No time limit to end of year tournament games.

14. Courtesy Runners are allowed by using the last player who was OJ.

15. No pitch courtesy (runner on 1st base), but walk/steal may only occur during inning.

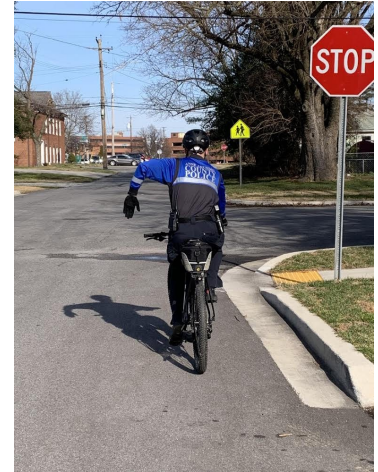

Live law enforcement and outreach activities utilizing the "C3FT" – a bicycle-mounted electronic system designed for the purpose of detecting, capturing, and displaying the proximity of passing vehicles

Throughout May, The Anne Arundel County Police Department, along with agencies across the region, will be conducting education and enforcement efforts to inform drivers about bicycle safety laws. In support of National Bike Safety Month, which begins May 1st, the Anne Arundel County Police Department is teaming up with the Look Alive campaign of the Baltimore Metropolitan Council and the Maryland Highway Safety Office in an effort to reduce bicyclist injuries and deaths by calling attention to the "three foot law." Drivers must give at least three feet when passing a bicyclist.

The Anne Arundel County Police Department will employ the use of a new tool to assist in bicycle safety education efforts. The C3FT, which is produced by Codaxus LLC, of Austin, Texas, is a bicycle-mounted electronic system designed for the purpose of detecting, capturing, and displaying the proximity of passing vehicles. The C3FT was obtained through a grant provided by the Maryland Highway Safety Office.

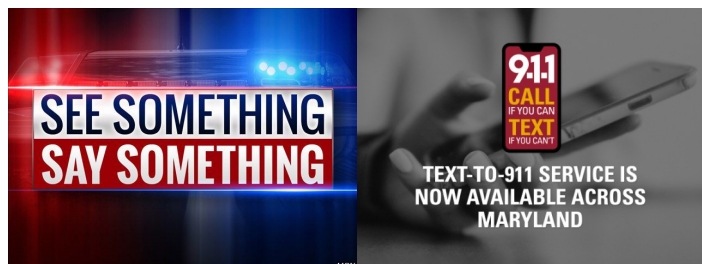

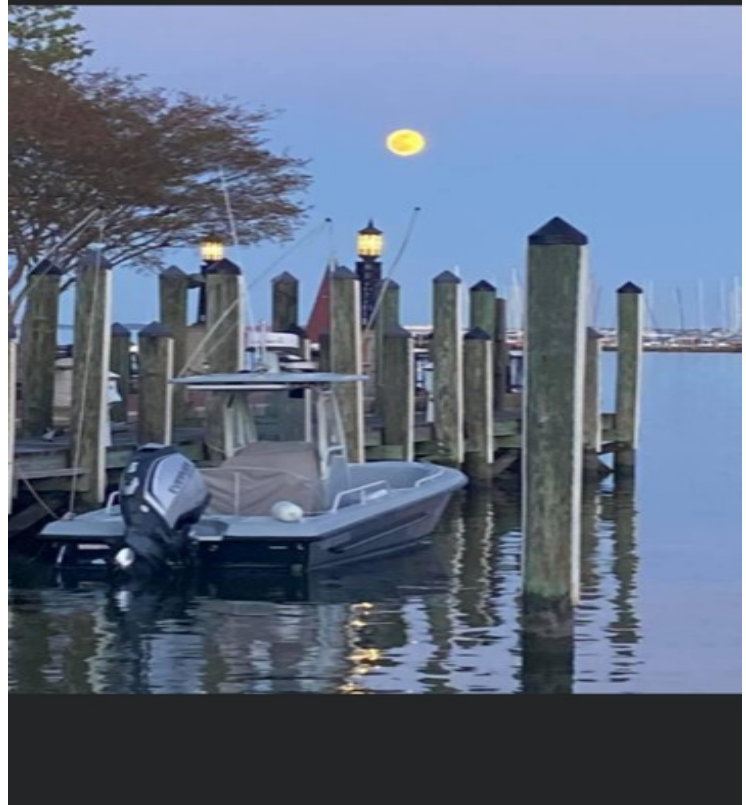

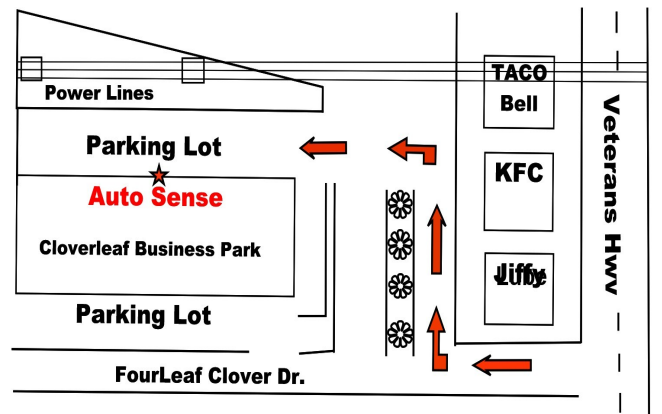
